Try to continue to read for 5 minutes each day. Remember to fill in your reading stars box at the front of your reading diary!

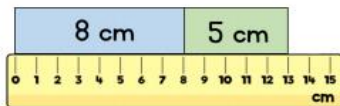

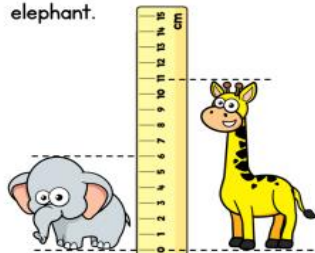
Problem Solving
