Dear Parents

We have organised a trip for all children in Class 1 to go to Brooksby Farm, Melton College for a Lambing experience on Tuesday 1st April. This will reinforce their work on animals and life-cycles.

We will be leaving school at 09.00am and returning at 12.30pm. Please arrive by 8.45 to allow time to prepare and register the children. Children will need a packed lunch. We will eat our lunch in our classrooms when we return to school.

The children receiving free school dinners will have a lunch provided by the school kitchen, however if you wish to provide your child with their own packed lunch please indicate below.

Children must wear school uniform and will need suitable footwear e.g. Wellington boots and coats in case it rains. We hope children will walk around the farm and park, explore animals' habitats and learn about them in more detail but the precise activities may change on the day if for example the weather deteriorates.

The cost of the trip will be £10 which may be paid as one lump sum or in instalments if you prefer. This is a voluntary contribution but unfortunately if sufficient money is not collected the trip may have to be cancelled. Children must wear school uniform and suitable footwear.

In addition to the Council's liability insurance the LEA recommended school journey insurance has been taken out for this trip. The school will cover the cost for this insurance.
