Dear Parents/carers,

We have organised a trip for all the children in Classes 5 and 6 to Rockingham Castle on **Wednesday 21st June**. This will reinforce their understanding of British History, particularly their knowledge of Norman castles. They will be leaving school at 9:15 and will be returning at 14:45.

Children will need a packed lunch. Children that usually have a hot school meal will have a lunch provided by the School Kitchen.

Children must wear school uniform and will need suitable footwear e.g. Wellington boots and coats in case it rains. The children will spend the morning receiving a guided tour of Rockingham Castle exploring 900 years of living history. This will focus on all aspects of the castle's history with special emphasis being placed upon characteristics of Normal life. In the afternoon the children will explore the beautiful grounds of Rockingham Castle, with its battlements, gardens and unique buildings. It is important that the children have suitable footwear, such as trainers, as the gardens are set in a valley with grass paths.

The school's No Smoking Policy and Mobile Telephone policy must be followed by all adults on this trip.

The cost of the trip will be **£8.00** which may be paid online as one lump sum or in instalments if you prefer. This is a voluntary contribution but unfortunately if sufficient money is not collected the trip may have to be cancelled. In addition to the Council's liability insurance the LEA recommended school journey insurance has been taken out for this trip. The school will cover the cost for this insurance.
