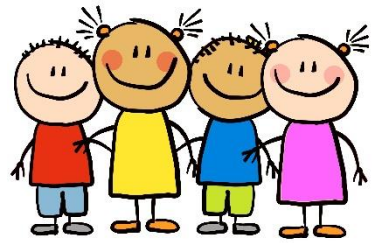

Here is a selection of activities for you to complete with your child based on what we will be learning about in school. How many can you complete?

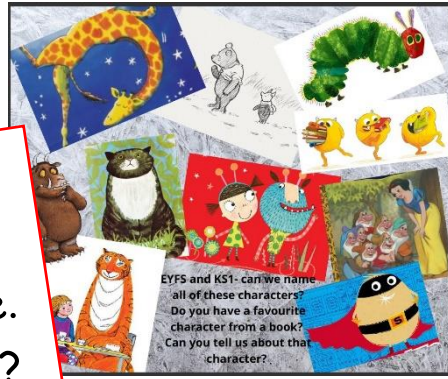

Make a picture of one of the emergency service vehicles using paint or collage.

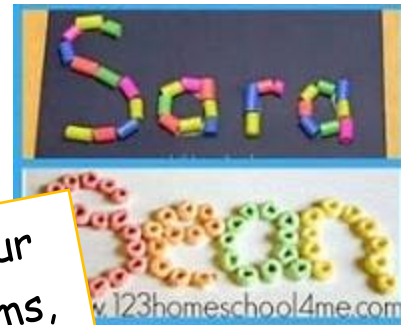


Talk about what to do if you have to call 999. Learn your address and your full name
