Do you agree?

Remember, when adding fractions you do NOT add the denominator (bottom number), that needs to stay the same. You should also be looking out for when a fraction becomes an improper fraction (the top number is bigger than the bottom). If this happens you need to change the fraction into a mixed number (when there is a whole number and a fraction for example $1\frac{1}{2}$).
