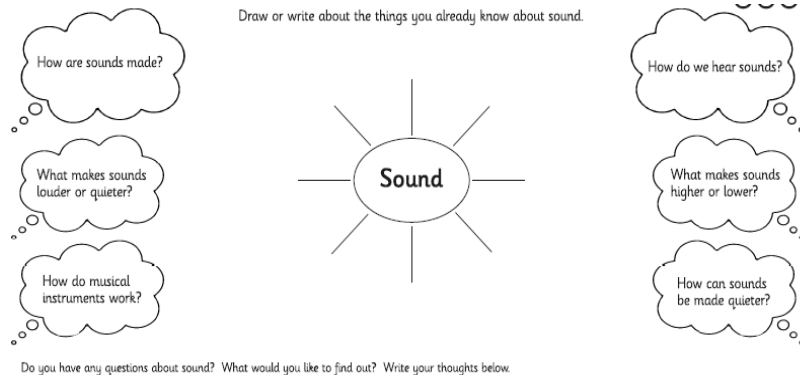




**WALT: Can I understand how sound moves?**

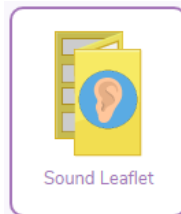
We can do an experiment to see sound by creating our own instrument.
