

**WALT - Can I write a newspaper report about a fairytale?**

The last few days you have been learning about the different features of a newspaper report.

Today, you are going to put all of those features together to write a newspaper report about Cinderella.

You will need to include:

- A catchy headline
- A stand first (Who, what, were, when)
- A main section where you include more detail
- A quote (using inverted commas)
- A ending paragraph (in the present tense)
