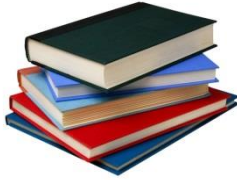
### Home Learning Week 8

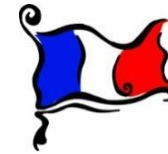
