Eg. do not = don't (the apostrophe shows where the 'o' would have been)

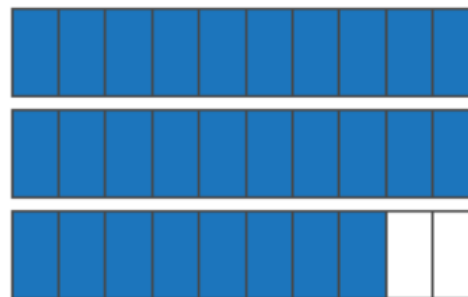
Ordering decimals

Practise your column addition by completing the calculations on the sheet in the home learning folder. Remember to keep your numbers in columns when you are working in your purple book.

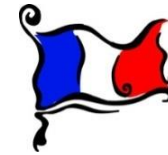

What is she saying? What is she thinking? How is she feeling?

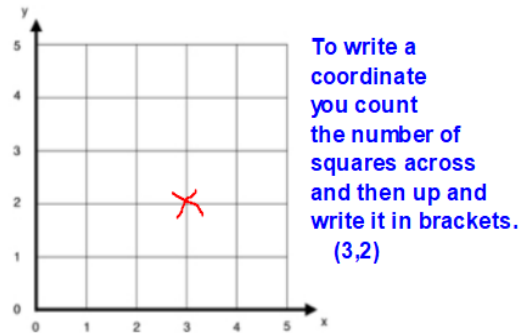
