Numeracy

WALT: Can I compare and order numbers to 1000?

When we are looking to compare or order 3 digit numbers, we must first look at the value of the hundreds to see which one is greater. If they are both the same, then we look at the value of the tens. If the tens are the same, then we look at value of the ones.

- = When two values are equal, we use the "equals" sign
- < When one value is smaller than another, we can use a "less than" sign.
- > When one value is bigger than another, we can use a "greater than" sign
