Watch this video to remind yourself how to double and halve:

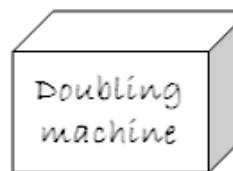

When you **double** a number, you are adding it to itself, e.g. $4 \rightarrow 8$

When you **halve** a number, you are sharing it between 2, e.g. $6 \rightarrow 3$

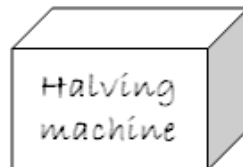
Fluency

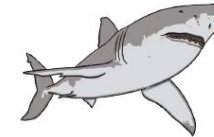
Read your book for 15 minutes at some point in the day. This might be your reading book from school or another one you have at home.
