Literacy

WALT: Can I edit my sentences?

We have to **edit** and check our writing to make sure it makes sense. We also have to check there are no spelling mistakes or missing punctuation. It is a great time to see if we can improve our writing too, are there some better word choices we can use?

Read the paragraph below. Can you spot anything wrong with it? Is there anything missing? Anything spelt incorrectly?
