WALT: Can I write a setting description?

Do you know the four seasons of the year?



*The four seasons are **spring**, summer, autumn and winter. The weather is different during each season. As the weather changes, plants change, too, and animals change their behavior to suit the weather.*

*In **spring**, the weather begins to get warmer and the days become longer. The trees and other plants begin to grow new leaves.*

How is this different to Winter?

Today, we are going to write a setting description based on spring!

Let's recap what a noun phrase is so we can make our setting description as interesting as possible!
