

# Present Perfect Tense

WALT: Can I identify and use the present perfect tense?

---

*In your pack there is a questionnaire called 'find someone who'*

*Task: Fill in the questionnaire with your family. You have to ask them each question properly.*

*Example:*

***Have you ever*** been to a different country?

*When someone answers Yes, I have, write their name in the first box and ask another question, such as Where? When? Why? and add that detail into the second box.*

---

What is the present perfect tense?

---

*It is a way of talking about something that happened in the past*

*but the exact time it happened doesn't matter.*

*For example:*

***I have*** broken my arm!

***I have*** been to Australia.

***I haven't*** seen Find Nemo.

***I've*** never watched a football match.

***I've*** played ice hockey!

*What do you notice about these sentences?*

*Remember **I've** is an apostrophe of contraction. It was originally **I have**.*

---

How do I create a sentence in the present perfect tense?

---

***You will need:***

***Have or has and the past tense of the verb you are using.***

*For example:*

*I **have** decided.*

*I **have** cleaned*

*I've **scored** a goal*

***Has** she **scored** a goal?*

*Task: Can you use the regular past tense verbs below to create sentences in the present perfect tense?*

---

cooked	kissed	rolled
crossed	laughed	scratched
destroyed	listened	screamed
enjoyed	lived	showed

*1 - These are regular past tense verbs with the suffix -ed.*

*Task: Can you use the irregular past tense verbs below to create sentences in the present perfect tense?*

---

sold	stank
sought	struck
spat	swam
sped	swept
spent	swung
split	taught

2 - These are irregular past tense verbs.
