
Words with Short /i/ Sound Spelt with 'y'

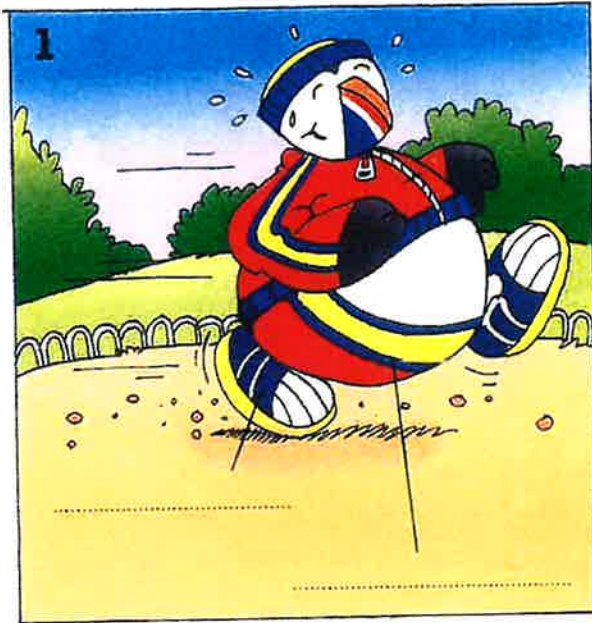

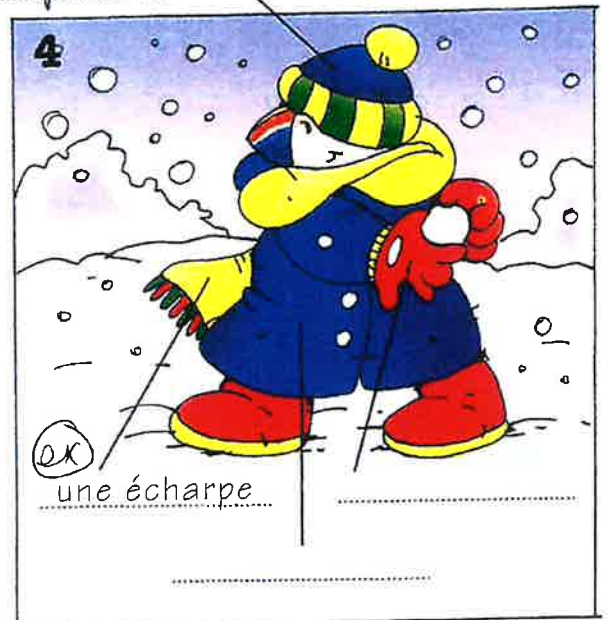
