Log into your Microsoft Teams where you will find a sway that has lots of videos of other books Tom Fletcher has written to give you ideas of what your character could be. Once you have decided can you draw, paint or make your character for your book. Can you act out some of the rules or tasks you might have to do with your character? For example will you have to flap the book because they set it on fire? Will you have to tickle your character because they are grumpy? Will you have to close your eyes and count to ten whilst you character hides? Maybe you will have to say something funny to make your character laugh! It can be anything! Write down your ideas. You can use ideas from the books in your Sway.
